Afterschool karate clubs encourage children and young adults to participate in sport. The afterschool clubs can provide a springboard for pupils transferring from school based, to community based activities. WAKF has a network of community clubs across England and understands the importance of supporting instructors running afterschool clubs.

Afterschool Club Affiliation to the WAKF is free and allows the Afterschool Club member access to some opportunities available to regular WAKF members to ease the transition between school and community sports for students, parents and instructors alike.

The WAKF defines an after school club as follows:

A Karate group or club that run's in co-operation with a primary school, starts immediately after the school day and finishes no later than 5.30pm for children up to 11 years of age.
