

Information for Japan trip World Wadokai Championships – National Championships

Hello All,

The Wadokai World Championships take place in Nagoya, Japan on Sat 14th and Sun 15th August 2010 at Aichi Prefectural Gymnasium, 1-1 Ninomaru Naka-Ku, Nagoya City.

All contestants and coaches will have to be in Nagoya for Friday 13th August for weigh in and passes;

Contest entry fee is free, a memorial T-shirt will be given free to all Athletes, Coaches and dignitaries attending, Athletes will need to let their group heads (Lee Minion – Winston Williams – Stennet Harvey – David Wilson – Peter May) know their preferred size as soon as possible be advised the S-M-L are children's sizes

We will be using Tokyo Inn Hotel, Nagoya as the base, the rooms work out approximately £60 per person including breakfast.

Can you please let us know your room preferences and names to rooms to be allocated?

We will book your rooms for Nagoya only on your commitment to go; payment for the Tokyu Inn is on arrival.

The number of nights you will need to book will depend on what day you arrive in Tokyo (please remember if you fly out of the UK on a Tuesday you arrive on the Wednesday most people are returning from Nagoya to Tokyo on Monday 16th August.

We are looking to make our base in Tokyo at the Sunshine City Prince Hotel, Ikebukuro, Tokyo Rooms work out from £61 per night breakfast not included (adjacent to the hotel is a huge underground complex with many restaurants ranging from subway to top cuisine)

You should book this hotel through Expedia travel for the duration of your stay in Tokyo.

The 46th Wadokai All Japan Karatedo Championships will be held on 21st – 22nd August August 21st Urayasu park Gymnasium, Tokyo; Finals August 22nd Nippon Budokan, Tokyo

All Athletes and Coaches will need to make themselves available for the Friday afternoon 20th August for weigh in and passes. Entry fee for the Championships is approximately £30 per category all athletes, coaches and dignitaries will receive a commemorative gift.

Budo Members who will be training with Yanagawa Sensei we recommend the Sunshine City Prince Hotel for the duration of your stay.

We recommend the Japan Rail Pass for the duration of your stay depending if you wish to travel around Japan for instance the return rail journey from Tokyo to Nagoya would cost you £150 return from Narita Airport to Tokyo will cost £30 each way you can buy the pass from www.japantravel.co.uk the cost is 7 day pass - Adults £208 - Children £104 - 14 day pass Adults £332 - Children £166.
